RAPPORTEUR

A One Day Centenary Seminar on "Life and works of Pandit A. Brajabihari Sharma" which was organised by Sahitya Akademi and N.G. College, Imphal was held on Tuesday, 25th April 2017 at Jubilee Hall, N.G. College, Imphal.

There were three sessions of the Seminar, namely the Inaugural Session, First Session and Second Session. The Inaugural Session started from around 9:00 a.m. The Welcome Address was given by Gautam Paul, Officer-in-charge, Sahitya Akademi, Kolkata. In his speech, he talked about a wide range literary scholar of Pandit A. Brajabihari Sharma and his contribution to the growth of Manipuri Literature.

The introductory speech of the seminar was given by Prof. H. Bihari Singh, Convenor, Manipur Advisory Board, Sahitya Akademi. In his talk, he described the various such seminars which were held under Sahitya Akademi in collaboration with other literary institutions/Organizations for the development of literature in Manipur. He also stressed the need for further such seminars in future to explore the literary skills of scholars of Manipur. In the presidential speech of the seminar Dr. Y. Momon Devi, Principal N.G. College thanked Sahitya Akademi specially Gautam Paul, Officer-in-charge, Sahitya Akademi for his keen interest in the development of Manipur Literally and organising the seminar at N.G. College. She thanked all the members of the organisers of this seminar specially Prof. S. Bihari Singh. She also thanked S. Indrajit Singh, Associate Professor, N.G. College for initiating and organising such seminar.

The vote of thanks of the seminar was given by Dr. N. Achouba, Director, DDU KAUSHAL Centre, N.G. College. The inaugural session came to an end at 10:30 a.m.

The first session of the seminar started just after the inaugural session. The first session was chaired by Khumanthem Prakash Singh, an imminent literary scholar and academician. There were three paper readers. The first paper reader namely A. Ramakanta Sharma's paper was titled "Life and works of A. Brajabihari Sharma" which briefly and vividly dealt with the various works and literary contribution of the Pandit. The second paper was read by Acharya L. Sharatchandra Sharma which was titled "A. Brajabihari Sharma as a Sanskrit Scholar" and the paper discussed the detail of A. Brajabihari Sharma as brilliant scholar. He also mentioned that the Pandit got gold medal in Sanskrit and President's Award for his contribution and propagation of Sanskrit in Manipur. The third paper was read by W. Jugindro Singh which was titled "A. Brajabihari Sharma as an Academician". This paper also discussed the academic contribution specially his propagation and development of Sanskrit in Manipur.

After the end of first session there was a lunch at 1:30 p.m. The Second session was chaired by K. Radhakumar Singh, IAS, Commissioner Works, Government of Manipur. There were three paper readers. The first paper was read by Acharya M. Chandrakanta Sharma which was titled "A. Brajabihari Sharma as a Grammarian". The paper mainly discussed for his contribution to the development of Manipur Grammar. The titled of the second paper was "Pandit A. Brajabihari Sharma's Contribution to Manipuri Literature". The paper was written by Prof. P. Nabachandra Singh which vividly discussed the Pandit's contribution to the development of Manipuri Literature. The third paper was read by Dr. Lanchenba Meitei which was titled "Pandit A. Brajabihari Sharma as a Translator". The paper discussed Pandit Brajabihari Sharma's translation works specially "Abhijan Sankuntalam" because it was translated from the original Sanskrit work of Mahakabi Kalidas. So, this translation work of Sakuntala had a special literary taste of reading.

After chairperson K. Radhakumar Singh gave a brief analysis of the three papers, the second session came into an end at 4:00 p.m.


